Do not wait until the last minute before an assignment or project is due to ask.

Late Work:

All assignments have a specific due date and future assignments are built upon the skills you learn. Do not fall behind. If an assignment is not turned in by the Friday of the week it was due you will be given a zero for the grade. For example: If you have a vocabulary assignment due Tuesday and could not complete it, it will be considered late. However, as long as it is turned in by noon that Friday you will still have the chance to receive full credit. If it is not turned in until the following Monday, it's a zero in powerschool.
