**Step 1: Daily Objective**

Mon 28: Practice applying latitude and longitude skills to various points on different maps.

Tues 29: Recall skills learned in the past week about longitude and latitude and apply them to the formative quiz.

Wed 30: 6.3.2: Use latitude and longitude to locate major cities around the world using GPS.

Thurs 31: 6.3.2: Use latitude and longitude to locate cities and bodies of water using GPS.

Fri 1: Discuss and analyze how do current events affect your life here in Hammond and elsewhere?

**Step 2: Instruction (What will the teachers do?)**

Mon 28: Students will practice their map skills on the Find the Coordinates worksheet and the Latitude and Longitude Activity 1 & 2.

Tues 29: Students will apply their learned skills to the formative quiz. Once everyone is done with the quiz, students will learn how to use and read information on Google Earth.

Wed 30: Students will apply Google Earth skills from yesterday to complete the Crack the Code Challenge with a partner.

Thurs 31: Students will independently apply the cumulation of learned skills and apps to compete the Latitude and Longitude skills worksheet in showbie.

Fri 1: All worksheets from this week are due today. We will also watch an episode of CNN Student news and discuss the goings on around the world and how they impact Hammond and the U.S.

**Step 4: Evidence of Rigor**

DOK 1: **Recall, identify, and explain** previous learned information about Google Earth, latitude, and longitude.

DOK 2: **Interpret** the author's purpose/perspective in the actively learn reading articles for the week.

DOK 3: **Input** coordinates and locations to **assess** what the location's coordinates are OR to **assess** the location of the coordinates.

DOK 4: **Analyze** the roll current events play in our daily lives and how they shape our future.
