Step 1: Daily Objective

Mon 22: Explain how patricians and plebeians are alike and different in the Roman republic.

Tues 23-Thurs 25: Investigate an aspect of Ancient Rome and create a lesson to teach the class about it.

Fri 26: How can current events influence your life?

Step 2: Instruction (What will the teachers do?)

Mon 22: Teacher will guide students through the notes on the Roman republic, the structure of the republic, and the conflict found in the republic. Homework is to complete the patricians and plebeians worksheet in showbie; due Friday, and SS IXL H.2; due Monday.

Tues 23: Teacher will introduce and explain the Roman Republic activity. Students will work in groups to create a lesson to teach the class about a particular aspect of Roman life. Students will present their lessons on Thursday. Worth 20 points.

Wed 24: Students will continue to work on the Roman republic activity; teacher will monitor progress.

Thurs 25: Students will present their mini-lessons on the Roman republic today. Teacher will grade as the mini-lessons are presented.

Fri 26: The class will watch today's episode of CNN Student News and discuss the topics mentioned and how they may affect us locally and nationally.

Step 4: Evidence of Rigor

DOK 1: Identify how the Roman republic operated and how people of various stations in life are treated.

DOK 2: **Distinguish between** relevant and irrelevant information when compiling information for the mini Roman republic lesson.

DOK 3: Create a mini-lesson teaching the class about a particular aspect of the Roman republic and life.

DOK 4: Compare and contrast how patricians and plebeians are treated and live in the Roman republic.
